Dear Prayer Partners,

On the hottest day of this year, here on the island of Flores, we are sitting on the edge of a lake in beautiful Guatemala. In one hour, we will be picked up for a meeting with a select group of Godly pastors of several denominations. Our time will be spent discussing essential aspects of revival for Guatemala.

We are in the State of Peten, several hundred miles north of Guatemala City. Saturday night we had our first Pastors Seminar in the city of San Benito, then twelve hours later (Sunday morning) we rode two hours South to Poptun, where we held our second 3 hour long seminar. The combined attendance of these seminars was around 1,000. In each meeting as in all our seminars in Guatemala we have seen a hunger for the Lord and for His word. Our loving Lord continues to greatly bless each seminar.

We have learned to love the people of Guatemala. This country has the greatest percentage of Evangelicals in Latin America however it is sad to know that Guatemala has the highest rate of violence and crime in all of the Americas. This is an enigma: how can God' people not be the salt of the earth and influence every part of the society of Guatemala? Pastors and leaders recognize the problem and for that reason there is developing a cry to the Lord to visit their land and to heal it through His presence.

This explains why the message of revival and prayer is so accepted by pastors and church members alike. They all know that their country of all countries needs a visit from the Lord, a true revival that will change them and their nation forever.

We have invitations and opportunities to hold seminars on Revival and Prayer throughout this country. We have been invited to meet this week, with the Pastor of the largest church in all of Guatemala, we have also been invited to meet with the "Superintendent" of 3,000 churches, and we have

been invited to attend and most likely, to speak on revival in Guatemala to 40,000 members of the largest denomination in Guatemala's National Stadium (this Saturday).

Please pray that God will send the first revival in Latin American history to Guatemala and that it will then spread throughout all of the Americas, including the United States.
