Dear family and prayer warriors,

We arrived last night after a 13 ½ hour trip to Huehuetenango. When we arrived our hotel at 8pm there were 22 men waiting to greet us. Seven of these men had traveled 5 hour to Guatemala City in January to attend our seminar. You cannot believe the testimonies of these 7 as they told how their lives had been changed forever in that seminar. These men had put together two seminars and a lunch meeting with their group. They rented the presidential suite for us, a brand new area of the hotel that is not to be opened until June 28. Judy cried for along time after they all said goodnight and left us in our room. We both were overwhelmed by their love and joy to see us in their city. We both are worn out and each of the three previous hotels we stayed in had cockroaches which are very disconcerting to Judy.

I don't have the strength to tell you how God used and blessed us on this trip. Today God blessed beyond anything that we have known in all of our travels in the last 13 months. We are within 30 miles of Totonicapan where the only true revival in Latin America occurred in 1932. Today I preached 6 1/2 hours to a packed auditorium to pastors from many churches and to a multitude of church members of many different denominations. The final service concluded and the response was was scary. No one wanted to leave the church and everyone stood there in complete silence even though the service was over. They all left the auditorium in silence. Cannot keep writing about this without getting choked up.

Tomorrow I only preach 3 hours without stopping and believe we have to shut down tomorrow night and not preach before early Thursday we start down the mountain on a very rough road for a 5 hour trip to Guate. Friday morning we leave for El Paso/Juarez. Home next Wednesday.

I have decided to send this to our prayer warriors. Initially I only had enough strength to write a short note to our family however our prayer

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needs are great. This afternoon in the middle of the seminar my eyes fluttered from side to side and I felt like I was about to black out. Several brothers came up and I drank some water and sat down to finish the seminar. We had an hour break and these dear brothers literally held my arms and helped us get back to our hotel Judy was with me waiting to be picked up for our two hours tonight and as the car drove up she said she could not go with me and went back to our room. Tomorrow can be a very important day for evangelicals in Guatemala and throughout Latin America because 354 pastors of one denomination are required to attend this spiritual retreat where I am to speak on revival for Guatemala and all of Latin America. These pastors are grandchildren from the first and only real or true revival in Latin America (1932).

Must quit and climb the three flights of stairs to our room. I dread the pain and effort required to get to Judy, our room, and our bed.
