

With a heavy heart we feel we "could" be leaving on our last ministry trip to Latin America. In 48 hours we leave on an 11 day, very fast and extremely busy trip to Guatemala. To avoid hotel expense we cram everything in to the shortest period of time.

We are <u>very grateful</u> for those who have sent money towards repaying the gracious loan made to cover our previous trip. Personal letters of gratitude are forthcoming. There is still several hundred owed and we are believing that this will arrive shortly.

Saturday in Chimaltenango I will speak to more than 500 pastors (preregistered) on revival, prayer, holiness, sexual purity, and church discipline. We then travel to Huehuetenango where for 5 days Judy and I will be kept busy speaking and teaching.

We strongly believe God is about to do something great in Guatemala that will affect the rest of Latin America. Our most recent seminars and preaching services have been blessed in ways that we have not seen in the previous 30+ seminars held in the last 14 months. Large numbers of pastors have evidenced that God has begun something in their lives that they have longed to know and experience. Many now have a new and a deeper love for our Lord.

The western part of Guatemala is populated by hundreds, if not thousands, of small Mayan villages. Less than a month ago we held a three hour seminar on prayer, holiness, and true revival for more than 500 pastors from all over this region. If I could do what I would like to do, I would spend as much time as possible visiting other pastors and church members in dozens of these small villages. My message would be, that because of the persistent united prayer of a small number of Christians in this rural area (in 1932), God sent the only true revival that Latin America has ever known; I would tell them how when revival came to that tiny church, the Christians were so "transformed" by the presence of God that 58 new churches were started in less than 6 months; for a long period of time, in this sparsely populated area, no less than 600 people came to the lord each month. In 2008 that would be equivalent to 600,000 coming to Christ each month.

At the beginning of this letter I said this is possibly our last trip to Latin America. When we began our ministry in Costa Rica 40 years ago, we accepted a spiritual truth. If God calls us to do something HE will provide the way <u>and</u> funds necessary for us to do it. "For it is God who works in us both to will and do His good pleasure" Philippians 2:13.

Judy and I are going through a soul searching period. Each of our last trips has been more blessed than the previous one, yet we have experienced more financial problems than ever before. We can explain some of this to satan and his furor. But there may be more.

We have not developed a financial support base for our ministry. We felt HE wanted us to be in Latin America moving as swiftly as possible doing what He has called us to do. We know this was God's will for our lives but now could it be that God is calling us to start presenting our ministry to churches and Christians here in the USA? Some people call this deputation and others call it raising support for ministry.

Our home church is the only church that has us in their budget. My pastor told me last week that our church gives 30% to missions and 5% of <u>every offering</u> is sent to our ministry. The check from our small church is the only money that we know will come in each month.

We will be obedient to His will! We are 69 years old and it hurts deeply to think that any of the limited time we have left on this earth should be spent here in the states raising money. If we discern this to be HIS will, expect us to be knocking on the doors of your churches asking for their support so we can continue our very fruitful ministry to Pastors and churches in Latin America.
