Dear Prayer Partners, Loved Ones, and Friends,

We are more amazed than ever at the Lord's leadership and blessings on each of our trips, but never more than on the last two.

Today there exists in all churches sexual sin that should not even be mentioned among Christians. At the Pastors Conference and the Bible Institute and in each of my 11 messages I touched on this sin. I spent a great deal of time teaching pastors how to prevent it from happening , how

to enforce church discipline, and how to restore with love those that have fallen into this devastating sin.

We were blessed to speak to 3 groups of Christian businessmen, and to challenge them to be men known for their honesty, their love for the Lord, and their desire to win their city and country to Christ. Judy spoke to the wives of two of these groups and they were greatly blessed by her message.

One of the above groups met in the offices of a bus company surrounded by "beautiful" over-the-road buses (at one time we owned four bus lines). Praying, surrounded by buses, was very special for me.

***(see picture above)* Meeting and getting to know David and Helen Ekstrom was a great honor for Judy and me. Both of these dear Christians are MK's (missionary kids) who have lived in Huehuetenango for more than 50 years, translating the New Testament into several Mayan dialects. Their last translation was dedicated this past week. Judy would like to write their biography. Reading their life's story would bless us all.

Some of the Christian businessmen in Huehuetenango are arranging to rent the city gymnasium in November (seats 5-10,000). We will preach and teach the importance of prayer and holiness If Guatemala is to again see real revival come to their country. The only revival in the history of Latin America occurred in 1932 at Totonicapan within 20 miles of this gymnasium. From Pentecost throughout the history of the Church, every true revival has begun with a "concert" of "agonizing prayer".

On the 10th of September, I have been invited to be the speaker at the 80th anniversary of the El Paso International Airport. From 1949-54, before my father started his businesses, he was the manager of this airport. Because I am one of the "still living" of that era, I have been asked to tell the story of the airport during that period of time.

While in El Paso we are organizing pastors seminars in Juarez and hopefully one for Hispanic pastors in El Paso and southern New Mexico.

Our great and loving God allowed us to fly to Guatemala, spend 12 days, stay in a hotel 5 nights, eat what we needed to eat, and return home with just enough money for us to live the rest of the month of August.

Our dear friend Andrew Plummer made 100 copies of our seminar DVD's and we hoped to sell them in Guatemala to help finance our trip. It didn't seem right selling DVD's so we gave away 75 and only sold 25. But God IS God and He blessed like the loaves and the fishes.

In less than 24 hours, on our last day in Guatemala, I preached 5 hours in three Churches, so recovering our strength has been slow. For that reason this newsletter and thank you letters to those of you who have stood with us, are coming slowly.

We still owe \$100 on the loan for our airfare on the previous trip. We believe that by the time you receive this letter, our debt will have been paid.

Thank you, each and everyone, for praying for us, for sharing in our expenses, and for the love we receive from your being a part of this ministry.

Prayer partners, you will receive a "prayer-needs" letter very shortly. Rigo begins a crusade next weekend and there are also many other prayer needs.
