This prince among men blessed my Judy. Because we are on Medi-Cal (Medicaid) many of her dental needs have gone untreated. Rene spent hours over four days fixing Judy's teeth. We will always be grateful for the love we received from he and his sweet wife Irma.

While in El Paso and Juarez we renewed acquaintances with many friends, one we had not seen in 50 years.
