These two trips could the most important trips that we have made to date. Two of the countries where we will hold large pastor's seminars could be on the verge of civil war. Each of these countries have presidents who are openly anti-Christian.

Next Saturday we will hold a large seminar in Nicaragua where their avowed communist President, Daniel Ortega, has a positive rating of only 20%. The poverty level in this country is one of the worst in all of Latin America. This pastor's seminar will be the

We have been asked to return to Bolivia the middle of December to have a <u>very important</u> all day pastor's seminar. Our seminar will encourage pastors and churches to persevere in a concert of prayer asking God to send a true revival and heal their land. Bolivia has been on the verge of civil war for several months. One month ago a Bolivian pastor was shot to death while trying to mediate a confrontation between government troops and a large demonstration. On <u>January 25th</u> this country will have a referendum which if approved will have a significant impact on all churches that name the name of Christ. PLEASE PRAY.

Rigo, as always, has done a great job of organizing our Nicaraguan and Bolivian pastor's seminars. He and Laura will travel with Judy and me from Costa Rica to Managua for our meetings in that country.

Before Christmas we will be in Costa Rica, Nicaragua, Peru, and Bolivia. We will also speak in San Angelo, Texas, Dallas-Ft Worth area, Phoenix, Arizona, and Burbank, California. We will personally thank two churches that came to our aide several months ago.

We will have the great blessing of being with Carlos and Martha Munoz. Forty years ago, Carlos and I started the ministry of Christians Sharing Christ in the market place of San Jose. He is
