**DEAR PHOENIX PASTOR WHERE

Thomas is just 24, and he came to our door because of the unsavory-"looking" characters that had been outside our motel room in San Angelo, Texas.

Charles was in the shower getting ready to preach that night and before he could come out, this young man was there, fixing the

broken door lock. After "due warning" that an unexpected visitor was in our room, my already primed and ready preacher husband began a conversation with this young man which resulted in Thomas asking Jesus to come into his life.

It was the same story I have heard Charles share over and over again. He asks "If I could give you a million dollars, what would you have to do to accept it?" Thomas, like many before him-- taxi drivers, shoe- shine boys, bellboys, fellow airplane passengers, waiters, bartender, and bank cashier heard for the first time how he could know Christ and receive Him as his personal Savior.

Thomas came to Christ in about five (5) minutes. FIVE minutes + a few more for brotherly love and encouraging words, and for the rest of his life, this young man is forever changed. Can there be anything more important or rewarding than seeing someone come to love Jesus?

In just four days (Tuesday December 9th), Charles and I will leave on a long and demanding journey to Santa Cruz, Bolivia, where several hundred pastors are waiting, hoping beyond hope to hear a message that will prepare them and their congregations for an uncertain future in a country on the verge of civil war. On January 25th Bolivia will vote on a referendum which could bring peace or war to a country whose people we are concerned about.

Those who will attend our seminar will be challenged to develop a life of prayer, and, by faith to persevere in prayer by standing in the gap for their nation.

The faith to believe that making this trip is possible, is being sorely tested. Yet, God has placed in Charles an unwavering sense of His direction. It is really a miracle in front of my eyes and those of many others when it comes to the gift of faith that is daily being exercised through him. What can I do but follow? Many, many times, my heart fails within me. There are so very many details to be worked out with only limited strength.

Over and over, however, the plan springs forth; amazingly, the pieces on both ends of the trip fall miraculously into place. How great a God we serve! How matchlessly and completely He cares for every detail, from the beginning to the end. Even though on this trip we will travel thousands of miles, in God's eyes Peru and Bolivia are just south, down the hill a ways.

And this is where YOU come in.

How we rely on, and are completely and unalterably dependent on YOUR prayers to even be able to "do" the "next" thing!

- The health challenges are REAL. Charles has continual pain and no feeling in his feet; he is more unsteady than ever at times, especially when unusually tired. I am battle-weary and insecure in areas that I never before faced.
- During the very few days we are at home preparing for our next trip of ministry, we deal with things that can often be debilitating and discouraging.
- The finances for this trip are supplied, and some money will be left for television ads to launch our large meetings in January.

There are many details to be finalized, but three cities have been chosen and each one will come in God's time.

- We cannot physically and financially keep holding meetings in the rural areas of each country. Leaders in several countries are organizing very large meetings which we hope will draw people from outlying communities. Much of Rigo's and Charles' time will be spent in organizing these meetings, and we believe they will impact each country for the Lord.
- The love and encouragement we receive from each of you is vital to our existence and fruitfulness.

## **WE NEED PRAYER FOR:**

- Tuesday's 17- hour travel time to Peru, followed by a 2:40 a.m. arrival in Bolivia on Thursday night, the 11th.
- That God will use us to impact Bolivia for Christ and that thousands of Bolivian Christians will, through faith and perseverance, see God honor His word by answering their prayers in standing in the gap for their country.
- That as we travel, we will have numerous opportunities to see people come to Christ.
- That each pastor will see his need to present his body, holy acceptable unto the Lord.
