Dear Prayer Partners, Friends, and Loved Ones,

Some have asked, "Why do Charles and Judy endure the physical problems of long and exhausting trips to Latin America?"

Forty years ago we arrived in San Jose, Costa Rica, believing that we were going to win all of Latin America to Christ. As we approach 70 we still believe that HE will use this same desire for HIS honor and glory.

Three years and three months ago, we made a five year pact with God. I asked God to use me to impact Latin America for Christ; I was then taking 360 milligrams of morphine a day and had been in an emergency room 37 times in six months. Both God and I have kept our parts of this pact. We have 15 months left in that pact and for that reason we are exerting every effort to redeem every moment of time we have left.

Let me repeat again what God has done in our lives in the last year and nine months. We have challenged more than 70,000 Latin American pastors and leaders to live lives of holiness and prayer. The purpose of our challenge is to see these leaders win their countries to Christ.

God is my witness; there is not another person on this earth who wants to win all of Latin America to Christ more than this "gringo" North American. Romans 9:1-3
