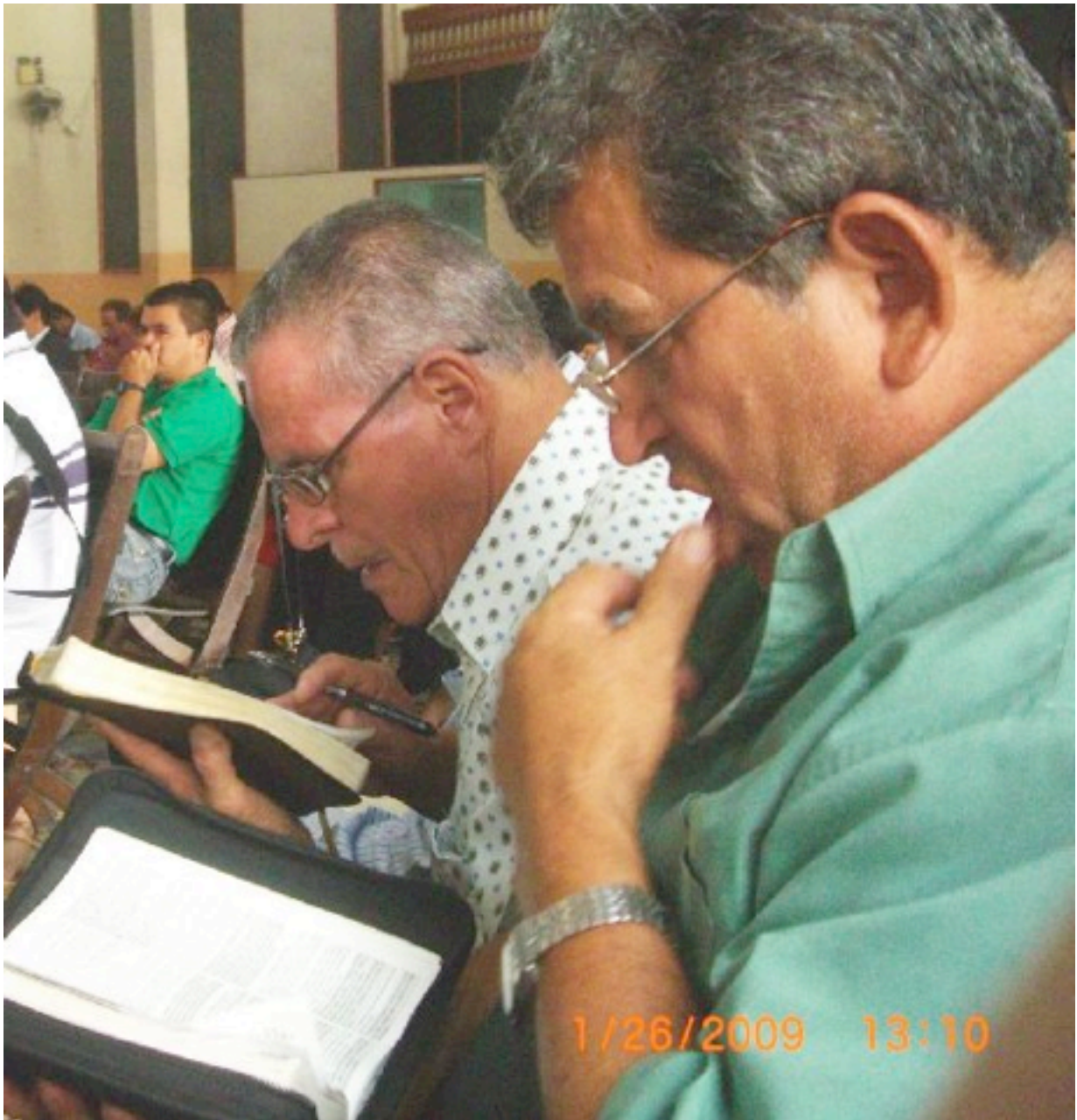

Dear Friends and Loved Ones,

Wednesday March 18, 2009



Our meetings last 2-4 hours and most that attend are very responsive and many take exhaustive notes.

We are truly grateful for your continued prayer support and gifts for our ministry.

Yesterday we received permission from Judy's doctors for her to travel next week with me to Northern Costa Rica. Judy's major viral infection, during our December trip to Bolivia seriously depleted important vitamins in her body. After weeks of exhaustive tests, doctors started her on a heavy regimen of vitamin D and after 5 days she is beginning to show signs of recovery.

Because Judy and I are not "spring chickens" (for those of you who are not from Texas that means we are not young people - I turn 70 on this trip) it is essential that someone travels with me at all times. For me there is none better than my Judy. Besides helping me personally, Judy sits in the back of the auditorium and intercedes during each service and then "loves on" the people as they leave.

The goal that God has given us for next week's trip is to see true revival begin in Costa Rica. One of our 7 services will be in a church where 50 people meet at 4 am every Saturday morning to pray for revival. We will be preaching, teaching, and exhorting large numbers of Christians for more than 16 hours in a 5-day period.

Rigo, Judy, and I believe that this trip will impact 6 Northern Costa Rican cities and hopefully *all* of their country. Rigo will be with us for some of the trip and he and I will share the pulpit during a 5-hour service near the Nicaraguan border.

With only 6 days until we leave, we are still \$800 short of what we need to complete the trip. Judy's ticket was paid for with her unused ticket from the last trip that she could not make due to her health.
