

Dear Prayer Partners, Friends, and Loved Ones,

For more than Two years, we have traveled thousands of miles and have spoken to thousands of pastors and leaders, about the importance of prayer “talking to God” and about the price to be paid to see true revival come to their country.

We have known that if God is going to visit Latin American for the second time in history, it will be because His people have cried out to Him, not for more blessings, but to in reality, know His presence in a way that their lives, churches, and country will be changed forever.

One week ago, my Loving Heavenly Father allowed me to preach four messages in three days to a church that desires to see revival come to their country and to Latin America.

There is no way that I can begin to tell you how God “moved” over this large number of genuinely broken people. Every service lasted a minimum of three hours; many would prostrate themselves on the concrete crying out to the Lord for forgiveness and expressing their love for Him. The last night there in Miramar, there was a large number of dear Christians who stood in line for a long period of time, just to hug my neck and share with me how God had blessed them and what they believe HE is doing and will continue to do in and through their lives.

That same weekend some 100 miles away, several hundred pastors from both large and small churches of all denominations met for 8 ½ hours,

and God's Holy Spirit moved on them, bringing repentance, confession, and reconciliation, both with God and their fellow pastors.

100 miles in another direction, in a church where I have preached many messages on revival, God has begun something marvelous among a group of young high school students. A 16-year-old, during recess, fell to his knees and began weeping, asking God for forgiveness and praying that his fellow students would come to know Christ Jesus. A Christian teacher, a member of the same church, persuaded the Principal of the school that it was important to "not interfere" as many were on the ground praying. She said, "This is of the Holy Spirit." Later, students asked teachers for their forgiveness, and others threw away their drugs and have forgiven each other. Felipe (Phillip) the 16-year-old, was one who had only been baptized three days before this occurred. Last week, at this same church, the members tore down a back wall and rapidly enlarged their sanctuary because the lost are flocking to their church and many are being saved. We have sent \$200 to help get the roof on the addition before the rains start, and to help purchase more chairs.

In one of our last letters, I told of a young 32-year-old businessman, who we have known all of his life, and who we love like our own family. You will recall that more than a month ago, early one morning during his quiet time, God convicted Esteban of how little he loved his Lord. God has become very real to him. You cannot believe the impact that his transformed life is having on the men who work for him, groups of young people from his church, and the lost.

On Friday we will begin the first of many series of services with the same message as last week: *holiness, being in one accord and one spirit, and revival*. Our first series is in a church where Rigo has been, and where the pastor is a man of prayer. During this year, 2009, this church has had members in their church building, praying 24/7 for a total of more than 1,700 hours. They are praying for revival to come upon each life, their church, their country, Latin America and the World.

Here is where we count on you to be a part of what we believe is the beginning of a revival in Latin America, a revival which hopefully and prayerfully will impact all of Latin American, and even the United States:

- 1. Please pray that there will be no counterfeit, no vanity or pride, but only a great awakening, which will result in millions coming to know Christ.**
- 2. Please pray for Judy and me as we begin this Friday holding meetings for at least a month in churches throughout Costa Rica!**

- 3. Please pray for our physical strength, and stamina. Four days ago I returned home with more pain than I have known in the last two years. I know that the Lord is allowing this pain and weakness to keep me totally dependent on Him for every word and every thought that is shared through this broken old body.**

- 4. Please pray that God will burden some to not only pray but share through offerings for our travel expenses.**

We will hold meetings in each of the churches mentioned above, and we will be able to put our arms around Felipe, Esteban, and many others who are willing to pay whatever price necessary to see God bless their country like He blessed those on the day of Pentecost or in 1932 in Totonicapan, Guatemala, the only true revival in Latin America.

Thank you for your part in this ministry.

Thank you for praying that God will continue to use us.

Most of all, we thank you for praying that we will continue to be hidden behind the cross of Calvary in everything that we say and do.
