We have seen revival come to churches and are fervently praying that a great revival will come to an entire country, which will then spread throughout all of the Americas.

We could fill a small book telling you the stories of Christians who have come under the convicting power of the Holy Spirit and have in brokenness repented of things in their lives so God can use them. My last sermon was on Colossians 3:1-17. Let me suggest you read all of these verses and especially verse 17.

Beginning tomorrow night we will preach the message of repentance and revival in 5 churches this week. The largest of these churches is in Limon, which is on the Caribbean coast and a 4-hour drive from San Jose.

Next week we will be on several radio and television programs sharing the message God has given us. We will preach at least 5 times, one of which will be in a large Baptist Church in Perez Zeledon, a 4-hour drive over a 12,000 ft mountain, a church where I preached a week-long series of meetings, 39 years ago.

Because of the increasing pain I have, Judy has made me promise to take two days off each week. I find it difficult keeping this promise. We have had to find hotels with soft beds (not an easy thing to do in Latin America) and have had to pay higher rates because of this.

We need your intercessory prayers now more than ever. Today we have greater opportunities to impact churches and nations because the "almighty dollar" no longer fulfills the dreams of many.
