Already a very blessed trip and we still have a week more of ministry before we return to our apartment in San Diego. Despite my keeping a promise made to Judy to take two days off each week, we are very tired. Enough about us. Let me tell you what God is doing in Costa Rica and Central America.

We have seen the beginnings of genuine revival in several churches. As of today we have not seen revival spread throughout Costa Rica. During an early morning time of talking with my Lord I was made aware that true revival would not come to Costa Rica until the cancer of child prostitution was removed from this country and specifically an area inhabited and frequented by many "Americans and Canadians" called Playas de Jaco. This Wednesday I will travel to meet with the "Christian" mayor of Jaco and then have a meeting and a season of prayer with all the pastors of that area. Our prayer is that God will tear down the walls of child prostitution in Jaco as he tore down the walls of Jericho. Please join with thousands that have begun to pray that God will remove this cancer of sin from their country.

Please hear my heart! God is doing unbelievable things through the ministry HE has called us to. The messages HE preaches through this beat up body express the love HE has placed in our hearts. A pastor can only understand what I am trying to say. Every message is blessed with large numbers coming under great conviction and many for the first time in their lives "falling in love with our Lord". Judy intercedes as I preach and together after each service we thank HIM for HIS love and grace shown during the preaching of HIS word. There is no vanity or pride in what I just wrote, only gratefulness for what HE is doing.

During this time in Costa Rica our fellow team member Rigoberto (Rigo) has been preaching very fruitful evangelistic meetings in other parts of this beautiful but needy country.

Rigo is a very special man of God who has the gift of an evangelist.

He is a graduate of three Billy Graham Association courses for evangelists. During one of these courses in North Carolina, Rigo had the privilege of having dinner with Dr Graham.

On the 5th of June, Rigo has been invited to London, England to attend Project Alpha's school of evangelism. This is a very intensive course on how to evangelize a country for Christ and invited only representatives from throughout the world will attend.

This weekend while Judy and I will be having services in a church over the mountain in the south of the country, Rigo will be holding an evangelistic crusade in a rural area about an hour away. Sunday afternoon, Laura & Rigo, Judy and I, will return to San Jose. Two days later (June 2nd) Judy and I leave for San Diego and on the 5th, Rigo leaves for London. This is to say that neither the Vega nor Moore families are letting the grass grow under our feet. Together our families have purposed to win all of Latin America to Christ.

PERSONAL FROM ME: My Judy has been a "real trooper" in our 200,000 plus miles of travel in the last two years. In different countries Judy has seen (in our hotels) 5 inch cockroaches, 10 inch lizards, crabs with large claws, 2 and 3 foot Iguanas, rats, mosquitoes as big as a bird (little exaggeration), fleas, spiders of all sizes and kinds. Most

insects do not bite me but all bite Judy and she seems to always have several swollen places on her arms and legs from bites. She has yet to meet a woman or girl that she does not hug to express God's love and thus receives a transfer of fleas and bugs. How grateful I am to have a wife who is a true helpmeet (a biblical term for a woman of God who undergirds her husband with love and prayer). Last night my love of 51 years fell down a long flight of stairs and is literally bruised all over. God's grace protected her from what could have been a fatal fall.
