Less than 48 hours ago I returned from an 8-day trip of ministry to Costa Rica. During each of our trips of ministry, over the last 2 years and 4 months, we have seen God's mercy and grace in extraordinary ways, however this trip He greatly worked in my life and it resulted in greater blessings than any trip before.

I left on this trip exhausted and very concerned for the health of Judy who physically could not make the trip with me. This was how my

loving heavenly Father began preparing me to be used mightily of him to preach 13 hours in 7 days.

HE increased my burden to see revival come to Costa Rica so much so that I could sleep no more than 3-5 hours a night, had no hunger and ate no more than one meal a day, and spent much time in prayer. How great is my GOD! In the wee hours of the morning HE taught me from His word things that I thought I understood but in my weakness the message HE called me to preach became even stronger.

God gave me moral authority to challenge forcefully and resolutely Costa Rican leaders, pastors, and church members to become Christians with a clean heart and clean hands before our living Lord so that HE could visit their country and heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14

GOD LED ME to begin the invitation in a large church in this way.

"There is someone in this congregation who is living in adultery and their sin is hurting the testimony of this church. No one else come forward only that person". Three people came forward under the conviction of the Holy Spirit to confess to the church their lives of adultery. That night 6 people accepted Christ and many sought people in the congregation to "get things right." There was much brokenness and repentance.

The last service before I left for the US, a practicing "witch" had accepted the Lord that afternoon and gave all of her books on witchcraft to the pastor. I challenged the pastor to burn them, which he did immediately. That night we knew the presence of the *LORD* and

during the invitation a taxi cab driver (Hugo) came in the back of the church asking how he could be saved.

Six weeks ago I preached a series of messages in a church, on what God desires before HE will send revival. The last service was very long because there was much brokenness because of sin. In the period since those services that church has baptized 26 and today they will baptize 9 more (last year they baptized a total of 6). A 15-year-old boy who for several years has had severe headaches from a bicycle accident is one who was baptized. The wife of the pastor put her hands on his head and only said, "in the name of Jesus Christ be healed" and he was healed instantly and has lived more than two weeks totally pain free and with no need for dark glasses. How great is our GOD! HE blesses our faith.

GOD is doing something great in Costa Rica, which could result in millions coming to Christ throughout Latin America. Pastors drove 6 hours roundtrip just to hear the message of repentance and revival. One pastor came a long distance by cab while others came and did not want the meetings to end.

Christians are to be known for their love. My Costa Rican Christian brothers blessed me by their love for me. Pastors and members alike showed me their love by seeking to make me more comfortable and to help decrease my physical pain. One pastor with much love took off my shoes as I sat with my feet propped up, another walked with me to the hotel to "protect me" and see that I got up the stairs without falling. "GOD is love" and when we love HIM, HIS love is known in and through us.

Last night, a week late, Judy and I celebrated our 48th wedding anniversary. I continue to be concerned for her health and we do not know if in 17 days she will be able to make the trip to Guatemala and Costa Rica or if she will be able to make the long and physically demanding trip in August. Please cry out to the LORD asking HIM to allow my love of more than 51 years to accompany me and be the blessing she is to me and to those who together we minister to.

Please continue to pray that GOD will hide us behind the Cross of Calvary and that HE will bless Latin America with the second true revival in it's history (1st in 1932).

We need your prayers and we need your financial support.
