

**SAYING GOODBYE TO RIGO

Most of you know that 4 weeks ago I underwent quadruple by-pass heart surgery. My heart stopped, which required a doctor to massage it for more than 10 minutes, until a heart pump could be connected. How great is our God to give us those doctors!

HERE IS THE REST OF THE STORY:

The Sunday night that Judy rushed me to the emergency room was the night I was to have had the honor of preaching in "the" church in Totonicapan, Guatemala, where in 1932, the only revival in Latin American history began. Our beloved brother, Heberto Garcia, the Superintendent of several thousand Guatemalan churches, had arranged this blessing for me and was to drive me 3 1/2 hours up the mountain to preach that night.

If I had been in Guatemala that night and not in our hospital, it is conceivable that I would have died preaching the message of revival in the church where revival began 77 years ago. I have always hoped that God will call me home while preaching the message of revival.

For two and a half years and more than 200,000 miles, we have physically taxed our bodies to preach the message of revival to 100,000 pastors and leaders throughout Latin America. Why? Because we know that once revival begins, literally millions will come to love our Lord.

For many months, on each trip, I had endured severe sternum and shoulder blade pain. We thought this pain was my RSD or associated with lifting our heavy suitcases or rough road travel. Little did we think that this was associated with my heart. I have lived

CHARLES AND JUDY:

Judy continues to be an excellent nurse and together we are going to redeem this time of rest. Doctors will not allow me to travel to Latin America until February (we have two unused airplane tickets for that first trip. Glory!) However, beginning in November, the doctors have given me permission to travel here in the United States to preach the message of revival. Please pray about having a two or three-day series on revival, prayer, and the victorious life, and then call or write us.

WHERE WE GO FROM HERE

God is doing something great, and we are believing HE will bless greatly.

In three weeks, our two dear friends Carlos Munoz (he and I together started our ministry in Costa Rica 40 years ago) and Rigoberto Vega (our dearly beloved team member) will have the pre-campaign meetings in the Costa Rican city known throughout the Americas for child prostitution. These meetings are to prepare that cities churches for their first ever evangelistic crusade. Four weeks later Rigo will preach the three-day evangelistic crusade in the large city park. Excitement is building among the pastors and their churches. There are several hundred more prostitutes in the city than church members, and we are believing that this crusade will greatly impact this city for Christ. Our hearts are sad that Judy and I cannot be there for the crusade and to see God honor the burden that He gave us for this city.

In January, Carlos and Rigo will hold a pre-campaign meeting for a very large crusade in Panama City, Panama. This will be a citywide crusade and Rigo has already made a trip to start the preparation.

As you can probably tell, my responsibility for these crusades is to sit here at home and help in the funding and to help in the coordination of the details.

PERSONAL THANKS

Friends throughout the Americas received word of my emergency surgery and a concert of intercessory prayer went up to my heavenly father. Prayer for my surgery was asked for on several radio and television stations in several countries. While Rigo was here, we estimated that at least 20,000 known prayer warriors had been praying for the doctors and the surgery. To those of you who prayed, we are humbled and grateful for your love.

We are grateful to the Christian leader in Costa Rica who paid Rigo's airfare so he could be here with us. One large church sent a large banner wishing us a quick recovery and all their members signed it. Other Churches helped us by sending us love offerings of Chocolate, special healing milk, and many cards. Members of our home church came to sing at my bedside but were restricted to singing outside, where many more were blessed. Three dear Christian brothers of our church who have had open-heart surgery were a source of encouragement as they daily visited me.

Thank you for all the prayer, hospital visits, calls of concern, and cards, but most of all, for your expressions of love for Judy and me.

- For the pre-campaign meeting which begins in three weeks followed by the crusade in the Costa Rican "city of prostitution".
- For revival, earth shaking revival to come to any country in all of the Americas and for it to then to spread throughout our continent so millions will come to love the name of Christ Jesus.
- Pray that HE will touch the hearts of God-loving Christians to help underwrite the \$2,500 for our crusade in the "city of prostitution". Please pray with us that God will bless this effort that HE has called us to make.
