This past Monday was the first day of our Crusade in Panama. Three hours after that night's service concluded, Rigo wrote the following," almost with tears in my eyes I want you to know how great our first night of the crusade has been... and how all our efforts, as difficult as they have been, were worth it all." This crusade still has three more nights before it concludes on Saturday. It is being held in the open air of a community that is known as the center of the drug trade in Panama. The first night there were 68 who accepted the Lord and as of the third night there are now more than 200. Rigo believes that God will continue to bless with many more coming to Christ. PLEASE PRAY FOR THE LAST THREE SERVICES IN PANAMA!

On the 18th of this month, Judy and I were to leave for a sixteen-day trip to the Cuchumatanes – the highest mountains in Guatemala. Everything was planned and organized for me to hold two pastors seminars and teach the pre-campaign meetings for our crusades. Rigo will preach these two crusades, which will be held in the two largest cities in these mountains. Our airline tickets were purchased and we had begun our preliminary packing when my cardiologist threw a wrench in the works. These cities are 6,000 and 8,000 feet above sea level. My doctor firmly told me that I was not to go above 4,500 feet until the 7th month post surgery. We wept! But God IS sovereign and we will not go where HE has closed the door. Since that doctors appointment we have been burning up the telephone lines between California and Guatemala doing all that we can to accomplish what we had expected to do in person. Our long distance telephone bill will be astronomical.

Last Friday night, in front of a live audience, we videotaped one hour and forty-five minutes of our testimony. This DVD/CD will include numerous pictures of events that I refer to in the recording. In our next newsletter, we will offer this disc as a gift to those of you who want to be blessed by hearing what God has done in our lives. HE took two little rich kids who did not know they were poor, and moved them to Costa Rica where they became poor but ever so rich in God's blessing.

We are taking invitations to preach here in the United States. We have three more months of travel restrictions that effectively keep us from traveling to our beloved Latin America, especially to high altitude places.

Judy and I will travel to Texas on the 2nd of February to preach in an English and then a Spanish church. These meetings will be in preparation for "revival" meetings we will hold in these churches the first week of April. On this trip we will also travel to East Texas for meetings to discuss an invitation to preach an evangelistic crusade in Zambia, Africa and to meet with a dear brother who we hope will write the testimony of our lives.
