Rigo traveled 19 hours in just one day to reach Barillas. The next morning, he taught our pastors' seminar, then that night, he trained church members on how to counsel and help the new Christians who will accept Christ in their city's crusade. Two days later, he repeated this in Soloma. Hopefully you can appreciate the physical demand that was placed on Rigo during this exhausting, but extremely fruitful trip.

There is honest expectation that more than 2,000 will attend the crusade in Soloma and those in Barillas are anticipating at least 1,000.

Here is where you are needed.

Many of you have prayed fervently in the past, for the ministry that God has given us (the Vega's and the Moore's).

Some of you have stopped praying as you used to, because you think my open-heart surgery will stop us from doing what HE has called us to do.

Let me assure you that you are mistaken and now more than ever we need your prayer.

For now, Rigo is having to do everything without our being together as a team. He has assumed my role, and then fulfills his own responsibilities in preaching the crusades. He does all that is needed, while I am forced to sit here in the U.S. We are looking forward to May, when my doctor will release me to again minister outside of the United States. We have a multitude of invitations to preach and teach spiritually hungry pastors and leaders throughout Latin America.
