"God is visiting Soloma"

Tonight, more than 3,000 people crammed into a tabernacle, especially constructed for this crusade. It was built to hold 1500, but more than twice that number were there to hear the first nights evangelistic message. There were hundreds without a place to sit. (See picture below)

God blessed this first of three crusade services as more than 500 came forward to make decisions. There were so many that there was not enough space in which to counsel all that came forward. That is being corrected at daybreak.

Soloma's two local radio stations carried the entire message and invitation.

This historic, first ever, citywide crusade in Soloma, Guatemala comes at much sacrifice of dozens of small and financial poor churches of the area. Constructing this temporary tabernacle, cost money they did not have to give and hundreds of man-hours they did not have time to give.

These dear Kankabal Christians proved the biblical truth that when we give of what we do not have; God blesses us with much more than we have given. They believed by faith that God would bless their efforts with many coming to Christ, so they willingly gave and God blessed their faith.

Tomorrow night, Rigo and the pastors are expecting more than 4,000 and then on Saturday night an even larger attendance (rain forecasted). <u>PLEASE PRAY</u> Each night, Rigo's invitation (only) is being interpreted into the Kankabal language, the native dialect of that region.

Rigo has and is now personally paying a price to preach this crusade. By faith we rented him a car to avoid his having to again spend more than 19 hours traveling over Guatemala's highest mountains in the back of a pick up. <u>Tonight Rigo's voice is almost gone and his tiredness after the 5-hour</u> <u>service was very evident.
