This week, Rigo returned home to his family in Costa Rica, after two and one-half weeks of preaching evangelistic crusades in the high mountains of Guatemala. Two separate crusades were used of the Lord to see several hundred people come to Christ, and an additional 2,000 made individual decisions about their life in Christ. One of the crusades was heard on radio through parts of Guatemala and Southern Mexico.

As this newsletter is being written, Rigo is preaching a four-day crusade in the South of Costa Rica. He will be preaching crusades during both the months of March and April. Please continue to pray that God will bless the messages He gives him to preach.

I am concerned about Rigo's health. Even though he is a young man, the schedule he has set for himself seems overly demanding,

Over the last 45 years, I have been a student of the history of the great revivals. Those that have changed nations and large areas of the world. The last time America saw a great revival was in 1858. More than a million people came to Christ. The interesting thing about that revival is that America was in worse financial condition than it is today. God has given me the faith to believe that our country is on the verge of seeing a revival of the magnitude of the one in 1858, or perhaps, even greater.

Historically, most revivals have begun in rural or the less populated areas. On our recent trip to East Texas for a meeting, we saw literally hundreds of small churches along the many country roads we traveled. Through much prayer, God has burdened my heart to preach the message of revival to as many pastors as possible, whose churches surround 15 small communities.

Beginning on April 2nd, and for a period of 27 days, I will preach 25 messages in 16 cities. Judy will be with me as I take the message of revival that God has given me. Through God's grace, we recently volunteered to give up our seats on a flight returning us home. As a result we have "flight certificates" that will pay for our airfare to Texas. By faith, we're believing that God will provide necessary funds to rent a car and stay in motels during this lengthy period of time.

We are excited, and are joyfully taking this step of faith, because we know that this is what God desires of us. Most of you will understand when I say that as we prepare for the month of April, we have faced heart-breaking adversity, which often times occurs when God is preparing you to be used and blessed of Him.

In May, the doctor's ban on my travel to Latin America will be lifted. What a joy, as there are already two trips planned!

May the 22nd, Harold Vaughn, a dear friend, who is also a student of revival will travel with me to Guatemala. He and I will teach an expected 1,000 pastors the revival message. Rigo will come from Costa Rica and help Harold and me in the six-hour conference. We expect pastors from other countries to travel to Guatemala for this seminar.

For the month of June, Rigo and I are praying about, together holding a large evangelistic crusade in the 15,000-seat soccer stadium of Huehuetenango, Guatemala. Please join with us in praying that He will keep us sensitive to knowing His Will concerning this crusade.

More than anything else, please pray that God will send a Great Revival to North America, as well as to all of Central and South America. When this occurs, literally millions will come to know Jesus Christ as their Savior.
