Many members of the churches where we spoke do not understand the term "revival". They associate the word revival with a banner hanging over their church announcing a series of evangelistic meetings. Because it has been more than 150 years since America has seen a genuine and great revival, few know that God can bless our nation with a mighty moving of the Holy Spirit.

We do not know when we will again be in East Texas, but we do know that there are pastors there who have our same burden for revival.

In 1858, America was in a similar financial and moral situation and America's churches were "dead". A burden of one young man resulted in 10,000 people in New York City, 2,500 in Philadelphia, and 2,000 in Chicago agreeing to close their businesses from 12 until 1 o'clock every day so they could pray that God would send a great revival. God answered their prayer and more than 1 million people accepted the Lord that year. That revival then spread to Great Britain in 1859 where more than a million also accepted the Lord.

#### **RIGO IN COSTA RICA**

Our beloved team member, Rigo, continues to stay extremely busy preaching evangelistic meetings throughout the country where we lived so many years ago. His last 3-day crusade was in an area of great poverty and God blessed with 36 coming to Christ.

### **MAY AND JUNE TRIP TO GUATEMALA**

We are grateful to God that my cardiologist has given me permission to again travel to our beloved Latin America.

Harold Vaughn and his wife Debbie (<a href="www.christlifemin.org">www.christlifemin.org</a>) will travel with us to Guatemala in late May to teach 500-1,000 pastors about what God requires before HE will consider sending another great revival to their country. Judy and I will remain in Guatemala for an additional week to hold meetings in other areas of the country

In June I have been invited to preach the message at a baptismal service of 5,000 new Christians in Guatemala. Rigo and I are trying to arrange an evangelistic crusade just prior to that Sunday service.

We have been invited to preach and teach throughout Latin America and as God provides necessary airfare, we look forward to accepting these invitations. One of these opportunities is to preach at the anniversary of "Peru Digno" in Lima (equivalent of U.S. Moral Majority). God blessed us with the privilege of being the keynote speaker at the founding meeting.

During our time of recuperation from open-heart surgery, we spent some time reviewing what God has done in our ministry in the last two and a half years. We were blessed to realize that during this time, we have preached in more than 150 churches, excluding the seminars. In our forty-four years of ministry, we can honestly say that God has allowed us to preach in more than 600 churches. Our hope, and prayer is that God will continue to give us the necessary strength to preach the message of prayer, and revival in at least another 100 churches before HE takes us home.

We are greatly saddened to report that a church we love has withdrawn their support of our ministry because their pastor disagrees with my "doctrine" on revival. God always provides necessary support for the things that are in obedience to His will and we know He will continue to do so.
