On our way to Guatemala City our plane had to circle the city for an hour before landing in a very bad electrical storm. The rest of our trip has been even more eventful (see below).

Harold and Debbie Vaughn joined us from Virginia and were with us in Huehuetenango, where Harold preached a powerful message in a local church. A large number of pastors were blessed with two sessions of one hour and a half each about personal and church revival. We are grateful for their being an important part of that pastor's seminar, as well as a being a personal encouragement to our own calling for revival.

This last week, we preached/taught two more pastors seminars in different areas of Guatemala. God blessed each of these seminars in very special ways. One group of pastors is eager for us to return to

spend a month in their area and preach the message of revival for two nights each in 12 to 15 churches.

Two nights ago, while sleeping less than 4 hours, God gave me the conviction that HE will bless Guatemala with a revival in this year. Space does not allow me to explain why I believe this was a message from God. We believe that a concert of prayer from you who are with us in this effort, together with those in Guatemala, and our own calling to pray is an integral and God-given part of revival beginning in Guatemala and then spreading throughout the Americas.

Returning one night from teaching a seminar we were pelted by small volcanic rocks from an erupting volcano. Our hair was filled with volcanic ash and we have seen that all of the roofs in the city are covered with this ash. The erupting volcano is located less than 10 miles from our hotel and we can see it from our room.

During that same night and the next day after the eruption, Guatemala was also hit by a powerful tropical storm that lasted two days and has killed more than 100 people and left thousands homeless. There are predictions that there will be heavier rains tomorrow and Wednesday; possibly more volcanic activity.

Guatemala's international airport has been closed since Friday afternoon and no one knows when it will reopen. Wednesday we will have to drive to San Salvador, El Salvador to fly from there. This will be a difficult trip, especially since we will have to be at the airport at 4:30 the next morning to catch our plane.

Judy and I will be at home just 7 days before I will fly back to Guatemala, by myself, to preach to more than 8,000 at the baptismal service of more than 500 new Christians. Please pray for this service because there will be pastors and church members from all over western Guatemala. Many of these thousands will hear the message of revival for the first time.

We arrived Guatemala with only enough money to pay for three days at a hotel. By God's grace, HE has covered the cost of our hotel room here in the city. By faith we believe HE will provide for our night in El Salvador.

We physically are not what we were before the open heart surgery. I am somewhat impatient for my Lord to return my strength, but we know HE has a reason for all things, and we rest in HIM. This past week we only preached 6 hours and we are worn out. Last year we preached the message of revival 23 hours in 7 days in two countries and 5 cities. Wow, what a difference a year can make.

We did have the privilege and blessing to see three men come to Christ apart from preaching. Two have already become dear friends.
