We arrived home Saturday night tired but greatly blessed by God for using us to lead an Eritrea taxi cab driver to Christ. Judy and I were overwhelmed by his joy in coming to Christ.

God blessed this trip tremendously and HE showed His love for us in so many ways.

We have now preached the message of revival to more than 4,000 in numerous churches in the mountains of western Guatemala and to an additional 1,000 pastors in that area.

In exactly 4 days, I return without my Judy, to those same mountains of Guatemala. On this Sunday the 13th, God will give me the opportunity to preach to more than 8,000 at the baptismal service for more than 500 new Christians. (see important last paragraph)

Two Guatemalan Christian leaders helped us pay our hotel bill and love offerings helped us eat. We arrived home with \$13 in our pocket, overjoyed by God's provision and goodness to us. When we are doing God's will HE will always provide what is necessary.

Support for our ministry has declined significantly, and our trip this week is not paid for, so we are seeking His leadership on what HE is saying to us. PLEASE JOIN US IN PRAYER

Leaders have invited us to return to Guatemala to go city by city, church by church, for at least a month. Additionally, there are seven churches in Costa Rica that want us to return to again preach the message of Romans 12:1-2, Prayer, and genuine revival.

There are also tremendous opportunities for Rigo and I to be used in evangelistic crusades in Panama and in Peru. PLEASE JOIN US IN PRAYER

We experienced a volcano eruption (rain of rocks on our car and ash in our hair) followed by hurricane Agatha that killed more than 150 Guatemalans and destroyed forty essential highway bridges. In one area more than 20 churches and pastors homes were washed away. One of our very dear pastor/leader friends and his family lost everything they owned. How we wished to have had money to help them.

In the middle of the night Judy was bitten on her lip by a spider and we rushed her to the hospital for three and a half hours of treatment. We are grateful to God that she has now regained all of the feeling in her lip.

A FACT! God blessed this trip in many great ways. Sermons blessed of God, 7 accepted the Lord in one church, pastors on their faces on the floor weeping and under conviction; time of powerful sharing with men and women of responsibility; 4 men personally led to Christ. Where God blesses, satan tries to destroy or cause problems. Thank the Lord that he could only try!

God has encouraged our hearts to believe that the meeting this coming Sunday in Guatemala will be blessed of Him in an extraordinary way and we believe that this can be the beginning of a great revival in Guatemala. This is not lightly said!!!! PLEASE PRAY FOR THIS SUNDAY'S SERVICE BEFORE THE 8,000, MANY OF WHOM HAVE ALREADY BEEN PRAYING FOR REVIVAL.
