out to the Lord to visit their country and asking him to know HIS presence in their midst.

God has provided funds to allow us to make this trip. We are grateful to those who stand with us in prayer and by providing finances that allow us to accept invitations where God can use us mightily for his glory. We try to be good stewards of God's money by cramming everything we can do in to the shortest period of time.
