Last week's newsletter gave little information on how God has been greatly blessing the ministry of Rigo.

Hopefully you understand that Rigo and I have been team members for more than three years. During this time I have learned to love and respect him like a son.

We each have a similar desire to win all of Latin America to Christ. Together we are doing everything we can to have the greatest impact on every Central and South American country.

Many Christians in the United States know how difficult it is to preach the gospel in Mexico, however in the rest of Latin America; four people are accepting Christ for every child born. Conversely here in the United States, at least twenty-five babies are born for every person who accepts Christ.

Rigo, and I strongly believe that we must redeem the time and preach the message of the Cross to the lost people in the areas of Latin America that have been overlooked. That means that Rigo holds Crusades in extremely dangerous high crime areas and areas of great poverty. His God-given burden is to give the people in these areas the message that there is hope in Christ Jesus.

Many Evangelical leaders throughout Latin America believe Rigo to be one of their most blessed of God, Evangelist.

During the years that he was with the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association, Rigo was trained in North Carolina in three of their courses of evangelism.

In my fifty-four years of ministry, I have known many evangelists. The difference I see in Rigo, is that he has a heart and passion to reach the “down and outs”. His heart to reach these people reminds me of the burden that God gave Judy and me to reach the thousands in the marketplace of Costa Rica; people who had no hope of sleeping in a bed or having even one good meal a day. God has given Rigo and me the same heart and burden for the unclean, unloved, and overlooked people of Latin America.

Allow me to tell you about some of the 21 Crusades in 3 countries that Rigo has preached in the last six months.

- 21,386 attended
- 4,095 accepted Christ

One crusade was in Panama's center of drug trafficking. One night, while preaching he heard gunfire close by.

To reach a city in the mountains of Guatemala, where he was to preach a crusade, Rigo rode hours in the back of a pickup truck over a rough dirt road that reached an altitude of more than 12,000 feet.

Almost every weekend he preaches a three-day crusade in some remote area of Costa Rica.

Rigo is highly respected throughout all of Latin America. As this letter is being written he has invitations and opportunities to preach Crusades in Bolivia, Peru, Colombia, Panama, Nicaragua, and Guatemala.

We can only accept invitations for Crusades when we know there will be enough funds to pay for the airplane tickets. All of Rigo's expenses during the Crusades are paid for by the local churches. These small churches cannot afford to pay for his airfare.

We are praying that in October, God will allow Rigo to hold several Crusades in the "Barriadas" (slum areas) that surround Lima, Peru. Our very dear Christian friend, Jorge Marquez, who is a City Councilman for the City of Lima, has offered to help us organize these crusades. Again, airfare is a limiting factor.

Rigo has three children who live at home. They are grade school, high school, and college students. He and his dear wife, Laura, can only

count on the \$500 that our little Missionary Board sends them each month. This is less than half of their basic needs.

Let me ask you to pray that God would lead you to take a step of faith, and start sending support designated for Rigo, and his family. Please ask your heavenly Father if you are also to help support future crusades.

MAJOR PRAYER REQUEST!

- For revival to begin in Guatemala, and for Christians in the United States to begin praying for revival to come to our country.
- For both Rigo and I to walk by faith and be sensitive to His leadership as we make plans for what he would have us do in September and October.
- For God to use us to have an impact for Christ in Latin America.
- For God to burden churches and Christians in America to become part in what He is doing in our ministries.
