The morning we anticipated an easy process of renting a car became somewhat of a nightmare. We were to speak to a large group of pastors four hours drive from Guatemala City. The deposit on the rent car was greater than the balance in the credit card. Back at the hotel we pondered how to arrive in time speak. Dashing to catch a bus we left Rigo's laptop and camera in the lobby of the hotel. The laptop was a gift from one dear brother and the camera a gift from another. It was necessary for Rigo to remain behind to make an unsuccessful effort at recovering his much needed property.

With much sadness we had to cancel that day's pastors meeting. Two hundred or so were anticipated, some who had to travel several hours, only to find that I would not be there. Knowing the sacrifice that many made to attend this meeting made the day even more painful for me I.

That night after a six-hour bus ride we arrived Puerto Barrios to prepare for a very busy day starting the next morning. The details of this trip are not as important as what we have seen in the hearts of a few pastors and church members.

A taxi cab driver heard the hour-long radio interview on what is a genuine revival and what God desires of us before He will bless a Christian with personal revival, a church with a real revival, and a nation with a great nationwide revival. Unbeknownst to me and without an invitation he came to the pastors meeting and I only knew of his desire for revival because the next morning he called the radio station while I was doing a second interview.

A dear pastor and his wife along with several members of their church drove several hours to attend the pastors meeting. You might remember this is the young man who called me in California asking for me to pray for him that revival would begin in his life. God blessed this young pastor during the several hours that I taught the message of revival.

Returning to Guatemala city I was already sick with a sinus infection and upon arriving I had to immediately go to bed. Four days later I am just now beginning to feel better.

Sunday morning I was so weak from the infection that I could not preach a sermon. I sat on the platform and read the first 12 pages of the of the translated book about revival. I was greatly amazed to see how attentive several hundred Christians were to the message of the book. Not many people would sit still to hear someone read a document for nearly an hour unless it contained very valid information that could change their lives forever.

Last night I returned to a church where I had spoken to their leadership. There was standing room only and many of these dear Christians gave evidence of being willing to seek the Lord and all that that involves until revival begins in their lives.

The God-given obsession to see revival begin in Guatemala has made my prayer to my heavenly father be very specific. Either let me see revival begin in Guatemala or Father, take me home to be with You. God continues to wake me up at three o'clock in the

morning to allow me to have the sweet time of prayer or talks with Him when nothing disturbs us. My nights are short as he continues to show me truths from His word and as He continues to show me promises that I claim.

I return home to my Judy on Wednesday the third and then by God's grace we will be able to buy airplane tickets for us both to fly back to Guatemala on Saturday the 13th. My loving wife of 49 years and I cannot spend any more time apart. In the last three years in obedience to God's call we have been apart for more than four months. It has become evident to me that I not only need Judy for instant prayer support on these trips but I need her to help keep me from falling. I had a painful and dangerous fall five days ago.

Five churches whose pastors are men of God and have a heart for revival have invited us to preach two consecutive nights in each of their churches. They each will invite at least two other churches to be present both nights. That means in 10 nights God will give me the opportunity to preach (not teach) revival messages to a least 15 congregations.

My Judy and I need two days of rest away from the computer, telephone, and dear Christians who seek us out in love. We've asked the Lord to provide us the means to spend two days of

complete rest in the colonial town and first Capital in Latin America, Antigua. We hope to do this between the first four meetings and the last six.

Here is what I hope will happen in the meetings beginning in a short 12 days. My prayer has been that God will visit one of these meetings and he will pour out his Spirit by letting us know HIS presence. My agonizing in prayer is that God will honor many of us who have been asking him to send genuine revival to Guatemala.
