

Dear Prayer Partners, Loved Ones, and Friends,

November 11, 2010

Rigo left Costa Rica early this morning for Colombia where he will do the Billy Graham type pre-crusade training for the three Crusades he will hold in January in that country. Each of these three cities have more than 100,000 people and they each have said that this is the first citywide united crusade in history.

Judy and I leave in less than 48 hours for Guatemala City. We are unbelievably excited about this trip. A week ago I returned from Guatemala where for the first time in nearly 4 years of travel throughout Latin America I saw the beginning evidences of a true or genuine revival. More about this in a minute.

God has opened some exciting doors for me to preach 12 consecutive nights (two nights of rest in the middle) to 18 different congregations, pastured by young godly men who desire to see God begin a revival in their lives, then their church, and then their nation.

Let me tell you how God answered your intercessory prayer for us on this last trip.

- Despite problematic health problems, God used me to lead four men to the Lord and I believe a young lady accepted the Lord but circumstances kept us from praying together.
- Whenever I preached it was evident first to me and then to the congregation that God was blessing us.
- We spent time with some of God's true chosen servants and were blessed by seeing the love of the Lord in their lives.
- We didn't know how we were going to pay for my hotel room and then received an unexpected e-mail from a dear Guatemalan Christian whom we had not talked to since before my open heart surgery. He said he wanted to pay for my hotel expense. Isn't our great and loving God worthy of our praise and gratefulness?

- We were faced with paying for Rigo's room but the hotel management said they would not charge us because his laptop had been stolen in their lobby. Again how great is our God.
- God always provides our needs and on occasion He gives us our desires. In our last newsletter I expressed hope that my Judy and I could go apart for two nights of rest in the middle of the 12 consecutive nights of preaching. I asked a dear son in the Lord who is in hotel management if he knew of a clean and inexpensive hotel in Antigua (one hours drive from our hotel). His lovely Christian wife works in management of another large hotel in Guatemala and together they have arranged for us to have special accommodations, in the best hotel in Antigua. Again and again, how great is our loving Lord.
- Yesterday's appointment with my ear specialist was to have had a small hole made in each of my eardrums so I would not have pain flying to Guatemala. My dear Dr. told me that he was prepared to tell me not to fly even with putting the holes in my eardrums. When he looked in my ears he said "I don't believe in faith healers but I believe by faith your ears have been healed." No holes and no pain! Glory to God for His love and mercy.
- For nearly 10 years Judy has prayed, that management would put laminate flooring on our second-floor apartment. Well our great God has caused it to happen and my bride of 49 years is ecstatic. For 15 years we have lived with the same carpet that no matter how hard we tried to keep it clean it still showed the dirt. To God be the glory for answering Judy's prayers.
- There are many more things that I could testify to that describe how our heavenly Father has blessed us in the last two weeks alone.

We are leaving on this trip by faith believing that God will multiply the loaves and fishes and provide what we need of what we do not have. It is a joy to walk by faith knowing that our heavenly Father knows our needs before we do.

Because of health and strength needs we are happily blocking off our days for prayer and study of God's word so that each nights service will not be a sermon but a message from God.
