My trip to Peru kept me from attending the funeral of Jimmy Peticolas, my childhood friend of 61 years, and business partner over several years in two businesses. One day soon we will see each other at the feet of our Lord in heaven.

Nine days after our 17-day trip to Guatemala preaching the message of a great revival, God had me on a plane headed for Lima Peru. This was a very fast but extremely blessed trip used to organize two Crusades for March in the very poorest slum of that city. Nearly 2 years ago, God burdened the hearts of Rigo and myself to reach the most needy people in the slums of Lima with the message of Jesus Christ. HE is now giving us the desires of our heart.

The doors have been thrown wide open for us to hold Crusades in San Juan de Miraflores, the poorest of the slum areas of Lima. We became dear friends with the mayor of the 400,000 people who live in huge areas where there is no sewer nor water. Trucks distribute water to 55 gallon drums, the people walk up to 30 minutes down the mountain to fill up their cans, and then lug them back up to the hovel they call home.

PERSONAL NOTE:

Some have chided me for saying that we can't physically continue traveling and ministering at this pace and that possibly God is ready to take us home. Judy has said she would be willing to live in a Latin American country for six months at a time, but knows we cannot endure many long hours on airplanes to reach places of ministry. Flying coach is extremely painful for my back and neck, trips by bus, and hours in cars on bad roads is often too much. NOT COMPLAINING!!!

We have gladly identified with Paul in II Corinthians 11:30, where he says he will glory in his weaknesses. Our pain levels seem to

Paul expresses our feelings at this point in our life, as we continue to try to reach all of Latin America for Christ.

Philippians 1:23-24

- 23. For I am hard-pressed between the two, having a desire to depart and be with Christ, which is far better.
- 24 Nevertheless to remain in the flesh is more needful for you.

42 years ago, God burdened our hearts to take the message of Jesus Christ to the people in Latin America who had no hope of ever having the things that most people take for granted: things such as a bed to sleep in, at least one good meal a day, and clothes to keep them warm. God blessed us by using us in the marketplaces of Costa Rica and El Salvador, and now again, he is using us to win the lost to Jesus who live in the slums of Latin America. To God be the glory!

God is love and two days ago HE showed me HIS love in a very special way,

While having dinner with a dear Peruvian couple, I happened to mention Cristianos Compartiendo a Cristo, which is "Christians Sharing Christ" in Spanish. The dear brother asked, are you talking about the film ministry? I responded by telling him about how God led Judy and me in January of 1969 to begin the ministry

in the marketplace of San Jose Costa Rica. He then excitedly told me how that for 13 years, God used him to show Christians Sharing Christ films all over Peru, and how he saw great numbers of people come to Christ.

The next morning in the two services where I preached, I met two more brothers, who also carried projectors and films to remote areas of Peru, and won many people to my Jesus. Do you realize that the ministry that our great God began in the middle of the marketplace of San Jose, Costa Rica, in January of 1969, has now seen many more than 2,000,000 people accept our Jesus as their Savior and Lord! In fact, the last report I had of the Christians Sharing Christ ministry, thousands were coming to Christ in the country of India. PTL!
