**JANUARY CRUSADES IN PANAMA AND COLOMBIA**

By God's grace, shown in some of your offerings, Rigo's roundtrip airfare to Panama and Colombia is completely paid for.

Rigo, on his stopover in Panama will hold several days of crusades in the same drug center where he preached a crusade several months ago. From there he will fly to the adjoining country of Colombia for the two weeks of Crusades in three northern cities of that country.

Normally, churches in areas where we hold Crusades, have their own sound systems or they can afford to rent this necessary costly equipment for their Crusades. This is the first time that due to their unbelievable poverty we will have to provide all of this equipment. Each of our previous Crusades transportation, hotel expense, and meals have been provided by the churches. This will also be the first time that the churches will not be able financially to provide these needs.

You read in one of our previous newsletters of the poverty that Rigo found in these three small cities of northern Colombia. There were

only three cars in all of a city of more than 10,000 people. Of course these did not belong to a pastor or church members. Because of flooding, which continues to exist, Rigo walked in ankle deep water to each of his meetings.

Rigo regularly communicates with these extremely excited Colombian pastors. For the first time in the history of these churches they are all united and have united weekly prayer meetings for their upcoming crusade. The excitement in Rigo's voice about these Crusades is palpable.

## PRAYER REQUESTS

- For each of the mayors meetings on Friday
- For dry weather which will remove the flooding and make the Crusades more accessible to the inhabitants of each community.
- For Rigo's health. He still has not recovered from the very demanding pre-campaign trip to Colombia and he has been working hard with limited resources to provide a good Christmas for his young family.
- Please pray that our little ministry will receive \$1700 by the 10th of January which will immediately be sent to Rigo to cover the above necessary crusade expenses.
- Please pray that Rigo will be hidden behind the cross of Calvary and he will be used mightily of our Lord.
- More than anything, we ask that each of you pray that many will come to know our Lord Jesus during the Crusade in the

dangerous drug area of Panama and in the three very poor areas of northern Colombia.

Without asking for specific prayer request let me tell you about what lies ahead in Lima Peru. On my very fast and very physically demanding trip to Lima I was able to see the doors thrown open for us to have two extremely large evangelistic Crusades in the largest slum area (400,000 inhabitants) of that country. God allowed me to tour the complete district with the mayor who has become a good friend.

Because of financial and health problems I do not expect to travel outside of the United States until I return to Peru in mid-February. That necessary, delayed trip will be to organize our large pre-campaign meetings and organize all of the churches in Lima to support the two Crusades in the large slum of their city.

We honestly know that in these large Crusades in Peru we will see many thousands come to Jesus Christ.

**PLEASE BEGIN TO PRAY FOR THESE CRUSADES.**

During January I hope to drive up to northern California to minister to Hispanic pastors and their churches. We hope some of these small Hispanic churches will become supporters of the crusades that we will be holding throughout Latin America. It is a sad fact that most English speaking churches in America have lost their missionary zeal to win the world to Christ.

You might recognize that I have spent the majority of my time in Latin America preaching the message of prayer, living a life holy acceptable unto the Lord, and the message of revival, to many more than 125,000 pastors and leaders in many countries. Besides teaching the 3 to 4 hour seminars, God in these 3 1/2 years has blessed me to preach in nearly 300 Latin American churches. In recent months it has been noted by some that God has done a real work in my life and it has been most noted in the receptiveness of God's message in each congregation. To God be the glory!

Our hearts are heavy that we are having to cut back on our personal travel, we do rejoice in the fact that we can still provide the necessary funds for Rigo to hold very fruitful Crusades.
