Tonight more than 600 accepted the Lord in the Pivijay Crusade. During the three-night crusade more than 900 came to the Lord. God answered your prayers. We are first grateful to the Lord for what he allowed us to see in this crusade. We then are grateful for those of you who earnestly prayed for Rigo and every aspect of the crusade.

Pivijay has a population of 38,000 and to see nearly 1,000 call on the name of Christ, will result in a very significant blessing for this community. What occurred during these three nights will be talked about throughout the region and we are believing that the message of Christ will spread like wildfire.

Last night Rigo delayed the start of the crusade service until the mass at the Catholic church across the street from the park had finished. With the young Catholic priest standing in the doorway of his church, Rigo with much love prayed that God would bless this young man.

Each afternoon Rigo has traveled a distance to a smaller community, Media Luna, to hold an evangelistic service in that community's park. The handful of pastors in this community were overwhelmed with what happened and have pleaded with Rigo to come back as soon as possible to hold a crusade in their community like the one in Pivijay. Rigo had already explained our

ministries financial limitations, so they said they would "try" to raise enough money to pay his return airplane ticket. Please begin to pray for the possibility of a crusade to be held in the very near future in Media Luna.

We had hoped that Rigo and Roy could stop in Santa Marta for a much needed two days of rest. However due to very limited funds he and Roy cannot afford to stop in this larger city and pay the \$60 a night per person hotel room expense. Because of this they intend to make a 10-hour bus trip to Rio Hacha where there is a "cheap and uncomfortable" hotel they can afford. The crusade in the small city of Rio Hacha starts on Thursday night.
