We are grateful for each of you who through your prayers and financial support helped make the four crusades possible. Two days before Rigo needed to leave for Panama, we were able to send him \$1,700 crusade expense money (this did not include airfare which we paid last month).

Rigo was greatly used of the Lord in the 4 crusades to see between 1,900 and 2,000 people in Colombia and Panama come to Christ. We praise the Lord for these new babes in Christ. We suggest you open the short attachment below to see great crusade pictures and hear some worshipful Spanish music.

During 2010, Rigo preached more than 30 crusades and I preached to more than 30,000 (15,000 at one time) in several dozen churches. Between the two of us we saw more than 8,000 accept Christ.

Rigo and I know we are blessed to be preaching in Latin America where the fields are truly ripe unto harvest. We both hurt for pastors and the staffs of churches in the United States who have multi-million dollar budgets and see only a few accept the Lord.

We sadly had to postpone my scheduled trip this month to organize our planned crusade in the largest slum area of Lima, Peru. We still believe God wants us to have two large crusades in Lima in the spring.

After mechanical repairs to our car we hope to begin traveling to preach in American churches, believing that God will lead some

churches and individuals to make a one year pledge to support the great things God is doing in and through our ministries.

Even though I will still be holding pastors seminars and preaching in Latin American churches, Rigo, myself and our board President have felt led to rename our ministry, Christians Sharing Christ Crusades or in Spanish, Crusadas Cristianos Compartiendo a Cristo. The renaming will take a short period of time.

On January 12, Judy's mother, Jewel Rankin, went to be with the Lord. Granny as we all called her would have been 99 years old on March 29th. Judy and her family will have a memorial service for Granny in San Angelo, Texas on her birthday.

Today, February 3rd, Rigo celebrated his 47 birthday. We are grateful to God for the way HE has used us and the oneness of spirit that we have shared during the four years that we have ministered together.
