

Dear Prayer Partners, Friends, and Loved Ones,

The test this week removed certain areas of concern but now I need to go through a more invasive test. This cannot be done until May 24th. My doctor gave me permission to make a 12 day trip to Guatemala and gave me his personal telephone number should any problem arise. We both do not anticipate that happening.

You might recall that during the wee hours of the morning, on May 18th of last year, while in great pain, my heavenly Father and I had a lengthy conversation. My pain was a result of a 16 hour day which included many hours driving over less than smooth roads to reach several hundred pastors to preach/teach the message of revival.

That early morning May 18th conversation with my Lord is when I knew for a certainty that a great revival would come to Guatemala "this year". I assumed that God meant the calendar year of 2010, which meant that revival would come by December 31. Now I am believing and for good reason (see below) that revival will come to Guatemala before May 18 of this year.

Exciting reports have come from Guatemala that a great revival is imminent. One church pastored by a dear man of God, has doubled in size in the last five months. The Bible school correspondence course of one denomination has doubled in enrollment in the same period of time. A dear friend described his arriving at a Saturday morning prayer meeting and he found all of the men on their faces weeping as they cried out to God to send

revival to their church. There are other evidences that Christians and churches in Guatemala are beginning to see the Holy Spirit move mightily in their midst.

As many of you know, for both physical and financial reasons we have not been able to travel to Latin America for the last four months.

Yesterday afternoon when my doctor said I could make the trip to Guatemala, my heart almost jumped out of my chest.

Last night by faith, I made my airplane reservation to leave for Guatemala in five days and return in time for my next medical tests.

We all know that the world needs an awakening or a great revival. Love for the Lord seems to be at an all time low.

For the last 46 years I have tried to read everything available about revivals. From all that I have read, I wrote a 30 page booklet specifically for all churches in Guatemala. My hope was to print 50,000 copies and distribute a few to each and every church throughout the country. This would have cost us \$3000 but for some reason God did not provide the funds. We were however able to see more than 100 copy machine copies distributed around Huehuetenango and to see more than 1000 Guatemalan e-mail addresses receive the booklet as an attachment.

Of great importance. God has been doing a work in my life during the four months that I have literally been stuck in my room here in the United States.

While I have correctly taught the message of revival, I recognize a great weakness in what I teach. I have not placed enough emphasis and importance on loving the Lord Jesus with all one's heart. I have not neglected the importance of confession and repentance of sin but have not placed the proper emphasis on what it means to love Jesus Christ.

Today there are prayer meetings held throughout the world asking God to bless their church and country with a great revival. God's Word (James 4:3) says "you ask and receive not because you ask amiss, that you may consume it upon your lusts."

When Christians and churches ask God to send revival because they find themselves in a difficult time and need "help", they "pray amiss" or in error. Revivals historically have always come after a few determine to love the Lord Jesus with all of their hearts. HE will not bless us with HIS presence in a great revival until we love HIM more than we love anything else on this earth. May you become one of a few who truly fall in love with the Lord Jesus Christ and fulfill what HE told us was the greatest commandment. Then you will see revival in your life and possibly see revival begin in your church and country.

Last night Rigo preached his first message at the crusade in the large Caribbean port city of Limon, Costa Rica. No report so far but we are believing by faith that many came to Christ.
